An act to amend Section 51222 of the Education Code, relating to physical education.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 351, as introduced, Salas. Physical education.

Existing law requires all pupils who are not otherwise exempt to attend courses in physical education for a total period of time of not less than 400 minutes each 10 schooldays.

This bill would require that specified programs and courses qualify toward meeting this requirement, including interscholastic athletic programs, marching band, drill team, and Junior Reserve Officer Training Corps. The bill would make other technical and clarifying changes.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

 - (4) Junior Reserve Officer Training Corps.
 - (b) Any pupil may be excused from physical education classes during one of grades 10, 11, or 12 for not to exceed 24 clock hours a time period less than 24 hours in order to participate in automobile driver training. Such A pupil who is excused from physical education classes to enroll in driver training shall attend upon a minimum of 7,000 minutes of physical education instruction during such that school year.

15 (c) The governing board of each school district that maintains 16 a high school and that elects to exempt pupils from required 17 attendance in physical education courses pursuant to paragraph 18 (1) or (2) or both of subdivision (b) of Section 51241 shall offer 19 those *exempted* pupils-so exempted a variety of elective physical 20 education courses of not less than 400 minutes each 10 schooldays.
